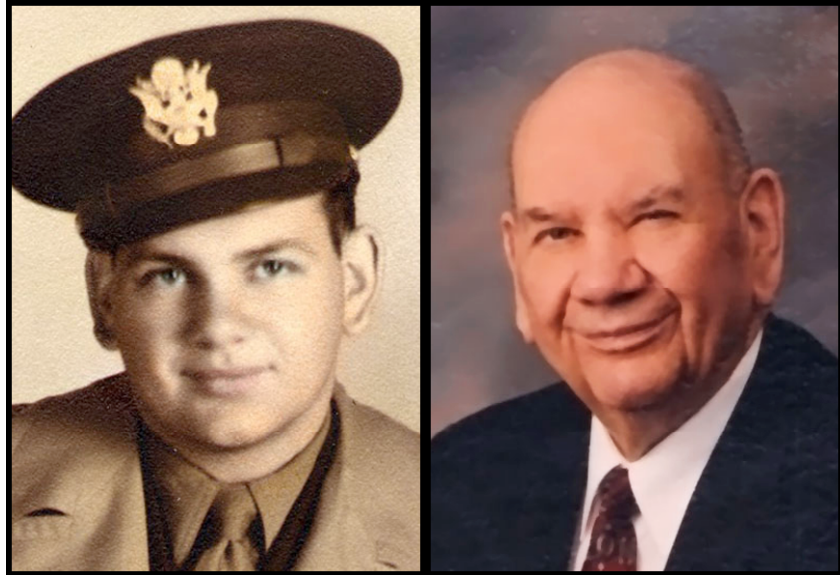


Andy F. Hobbs
