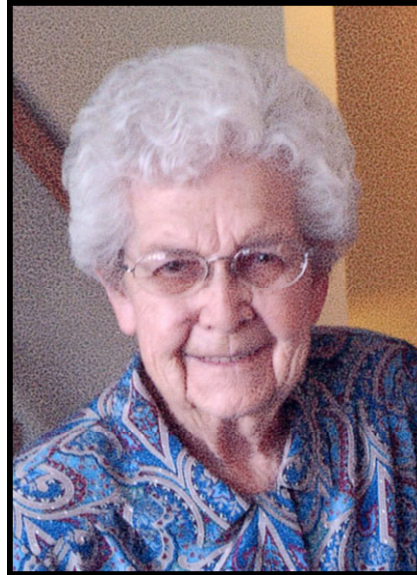


Chloris Nielsen Hansen
