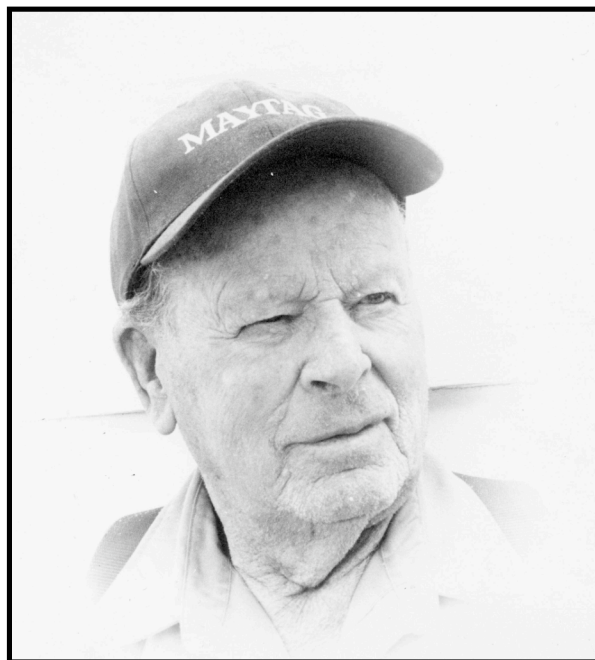


**Cleon Jesse Lloyd**  
**1914 ~ 2011**



Cleon Jesse Lloyd, born 23 Mar 1914 in Riverton, Utah, graduated from this life 14 January 2011 at his home in Midvale, Utah.

Jesse was the second of three children born to Cleon Oleon and Christina Ingeborg Andersen Lloyd. His father, Cleon, passed away when Jesse was 4 years old. His mother remarried Cleon's cousin, Freeman R Lloyd and 3 more children were born to this union.

On 6 Mar 1938 in Burley, Idaho, Jesse married the love of his life, Mary Lavina Boren. Later solemnized in the Manti Temple on 4 Apr 1963. To this union four children were born.

By trade Jesse wore many hats, including: silver mining in Lark mine, Lark, Utah, worked on potato farms in Burley, Idaho, had a route for North Western Express transporting theatre movies and snack bar items from Salt Lake City into St Anthony, Idaho. He operated and later owned Lloyd Cash Coal Company in Salt Lake City, Utah. Being a master craftsman/carpenter was his main trade for most of his life, working for Jensen Brothers Construction and later for Bettilyon Construction Company.

After retirement Jesse traveled and went fishing with his wife, Mary. She preceded him in death 15 Oct 1998.

He loved working in his wood working shop making all kinds of toys for his grandchildren and great-grandchildren. These toys included: wagons to trail behind tri-cycles, doll beds, wheel barrows, chalk boards, and marble games.

Survived by: sons C Ralph (Deanna) Lloyd and Philip K (Mary Jo) Lloyd, daughters, Shirley Lloyd and Janet (Micheal) Christensen, one brother, Kenneth R Lloyd, 14 grandchildren, 22 great-grandchildren, and 2 great-great-grandchildren.

Jesse is preceded in death by his wife, parents, three sisters, two brothers, and two great-grandchildren.
