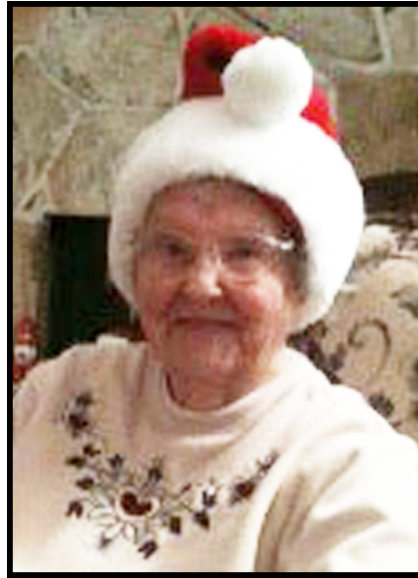


Freddie Ann Maasberg
