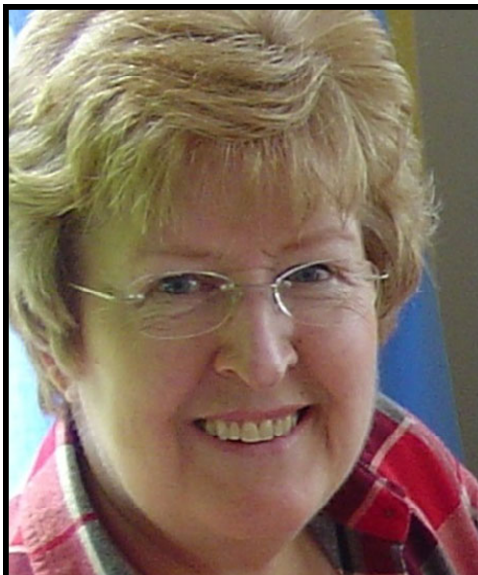


**Judith Kay Layton Richins**
