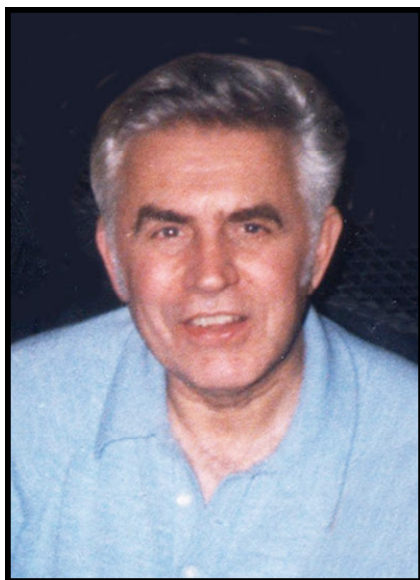


LaVelle C. Tripp

LaVelle Clarence Tripp, 78, loved and respected husband, father, and grandfather, passed away June 16, 2011 from complications of pneumonia.
