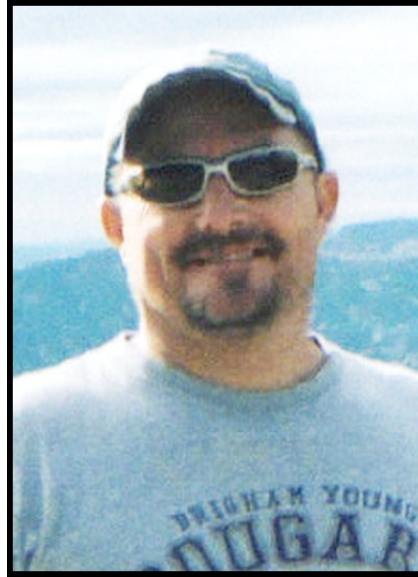


Mark Horsley
