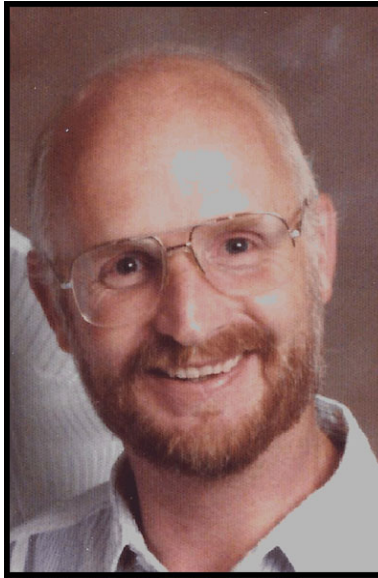


**Paul Jeffry Soper**
