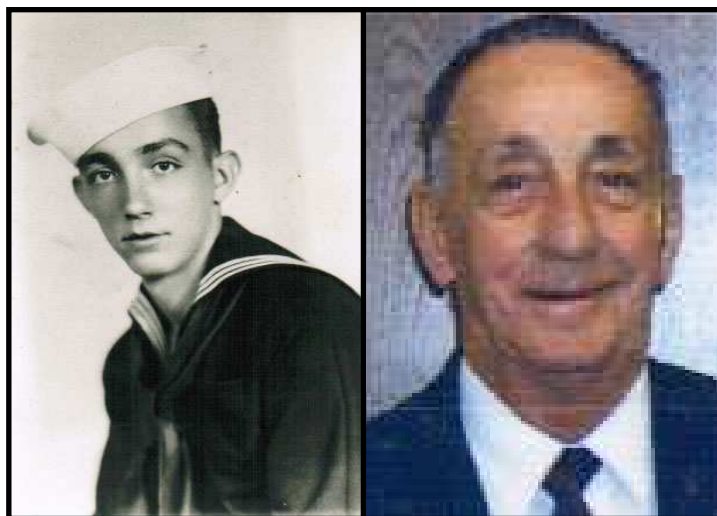


Ralph James Flitton

Sandy, UT - Ralph James Flitton age 86 passed away February 4, 2011 from respiratory failure after a recent operation. Ralph was born in Sandy June 5, 1924, to Curtis Monroe Flitton and Luella Rawson in Salt Lake City, UT. He served his country in WW II on the USS Mississippi in the South Pacific. Ralph enlisted December 8, 1941. His great enjoyment was to fish the Madison River with his friends, the Ballard Brothers. Ralph married Donna Atwood September 1, 1948. He had many callings but most recently served a mission calling with his wife for 8 years at the conference center and 15 years as an ordinance worker at the Jordan River Temple.
