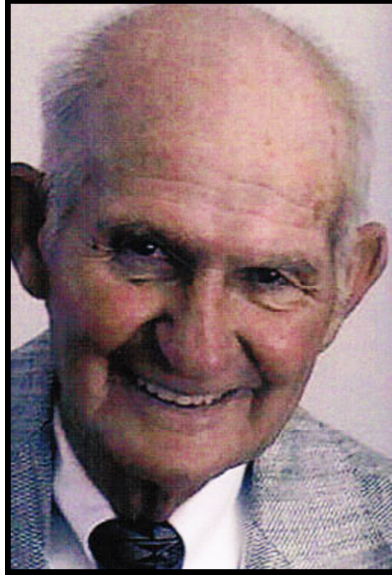


Raymond “Wick” Mousley
